Dear Dover High School Parents,

**Dover High School will move to A2: Modified Face-to-Face Instruction beginning Wednesday, October 14.** In this model, students in grades 9-12 only will receive Face-to-Face Instruction 2 days per week and Remote Learning 3 days per week.

This will allow for further social distancing in classrooms and common areas, as well as reduce the number of students affected by quarantine, while providing quality instruction for all of our high school students. Wednesdays will be used for additional cleaning of the building. Teachers will use this time to prepare for and provide remote learning, as well as provide supplementary instruction as needed.

In this model, all DHS students are divided into two groups: A and B. Students in Group A (Last Names: A-L) will attend in person on Monday and Thursday with remote learning Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday. Students in Group B (Last Names: M-Z) will attend in person on Tuesday and Friday with remote learning on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

On days that the students are attending in person, all students will eat at school. Due to a shorter lunch period, juniors and seniors will not be permitted to leave for lunch. Seniors will be able to eat in the Commons Area, and students in grades 9-11 will eat in their classrooms.

At this time, all students can eat a healthy lunch at school for no cost. For days that students are in remote learning, meals are available through the school food service departments on the days they are in remote learning. Please contact the high school cafeteria at 330-364-7130 by 9am on Wednesdays to reserve your meals. Pick up for the week's meals will take place that same Wednesday between 11am -- 12pm on Tornado Alley.

At this time, athletics and extracurricular activities will continue, as scheduled.

**This change will be effective through at least Friday, October 30.** The district will continue to assess the need to continue in A2: Modified Face-to-Face Instruction after that date and will notify parents as soon as possible of this decision.
