

Dover City Schools Levy Renewals Key Facts

Dover City Schools is on the Nov. 8 ballot with two renewal levies.

Both levies result in zero tax increase.

The two levies provide \$5.1 million a year for the school district.

The funding helps maintain the day-to-day operations of the district, including:



Teachers



Technology



Supplies



Utilities

These levies were originally passed in 2003 and 2008 and are for 10 years.

If passed...

these levies provide a stable funding source so our students can continue to receive programs and services they do today.

If levies are not renewed...

the district will lose \$5.1 million annually, or approximately 20% of its annual funding, which means a reduction in current programs, staff, and opportunities for students.
